

Travel grants for the IGU Congress

The IAG has a fund to support postgraduate students and early career geographers to attend the Congresses of the International Geographical Union (IGU).

Eligibility criteria

Essential criteria:

- You must be a current financial member of the IAG
- You must be either a postgraduate student or an early career geographer who graduated with a postgraduate degree within the last five years
- You must be presenting a paper at the conference
- You must be registered to attend the full duration of the conference.

Desirable criteria:

- You have submitted, or are intending to submit, your paper to *Geographical Research*
- You are a member of one of the IAG Study Groups.

After the conference those awarded a grant must write an 800 word report for the IAG Council. The report should outline your participation in the conference, your reflections on the conference and detail how you spent the grant money. Copies of relevant receipts should be included. Your report should be submitted to the Treasurer and also the Newsletter Editor within three calendar months of the conclusion of the conference.

How to Apply

To apply for funding you should complete the form below and post it to the IAG Treasurer to reach him no later than 60 days before the starting date of the conference. You should attach evidence of your registration at the conference and advice of the acceptance of your paper (where available).
